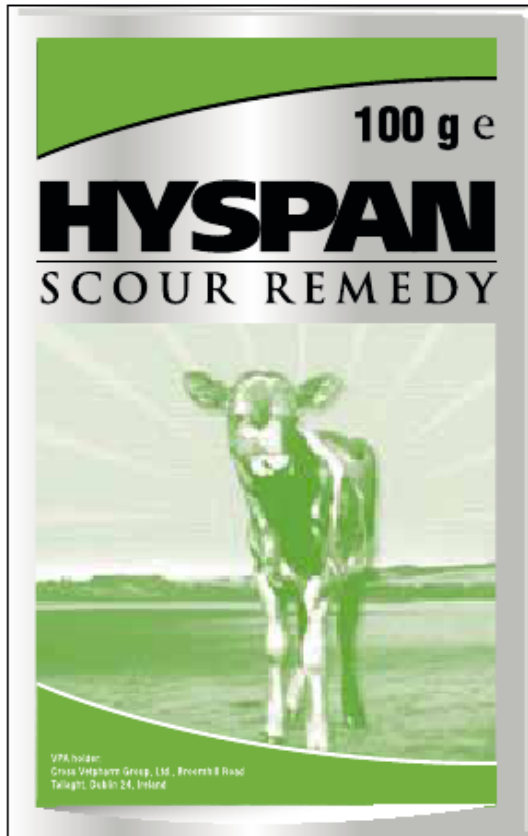

HYSPAN: A comprehensive oral treatment for scour in calves specially formulated to combat infection, dehydration and loss of electrolytes.

HYSPAN CONTAINS: Neomycin Sulphate – specially selected for maximum activity in the gut.

Electrolytes – restore electrolyte balance and relieve dehydration. Glucose – an immediate source of energy which enhances the absorption of electrolytes and water thus speeding rehydration.

HYSPAN: is an oral powder which disperses readily in water and is highly palatable.

Each sachet of Hyspan contains:

Neomycin Sulphate 400 mg; in combination with Sodium Chloride; Potassium Chloride; Sodium Hydrogen Carbonate; Potassium Dihydrogen Phosphate; Colloidal Anhydrous Silica and Glucose Monohydrate to 100g.

INDICATIONS: Scour in calves mainly due to E. coli and Salmonella.

DIRECTIONS: Withdraw all milk and milk replacer from scouring animals.

Calves: 35 – 75 kg:

Administer the contents of 1 sachet dispersed in 3 pints (3.42 litres) of warm water twice daily for 2 days and once on the third day. Start treatment as soon as possible after the start of diarrhoea.

The full course of treatment (5 sachets) should be given to avoid the development of resistant strains unless constipation ensues. Discontinue treatment after 2 days if no response is observed and consult your veterinary surgeon. Do not extend treatment beyond the recommended time. Hyspan is contraindicated in cases of known hypersensitivity to the active ingredients. Unused product or waste material should be disposed of in accordance with current practice for pharmaceutical waste under national waste disposal regulations. Animals should not be slaughtered within 28 days of the last treatment.
